2024 Pentecost Message

When we deeply reflect on the history of salvation of man, we will clearly see that the redemption that our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ attained for us here on earth was the work of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. This is why Pentecost Sunday is also known in the Eastern Churches as Trinity Sunday. It was the Father Who sent His Son to reveal His love for man, saving him thereby from the eternal damnation. It was the Son Who manifested His Father's immense love for man by His death on the cross and glorious resurrection. It was the Holy Spirit Who was sent by the Son on the fiftieth day after Christ's resurrection, having descended on His disciples as the pledge of God's perpetual presence in His Holy Church. Three Persons – One God! What an incomprehensible mystery! How can one not tremble just thinking about the mystical essence of our Lord and the marvelous works that He does for man!

Because, as I stated above, the feast of the Pentecost is known in the Eastern Churches as Trinity Sunday, it is considered, as the name suggests, the parish feast of the churches that bear the Name of the Most Holy Trinity. Therefore, I would like to wish wholeheartedly and in a very special way a blessed parish feast day to all parishioners of Holy Trinity Church!

The solemn and glorious event of the Descent of the Holy Spirit, which happened at Pentecost – “the ancient Jewish festival called the “feast of weeks” ... (Exodus 34:22; Deuteronomy 16:10)” (*New Advent Catholic Encyclopedia*: <https://www.newadvent.org/cathen/15614b.htm>) – is a joy-filled day for the Church. It is the feast of hope that God, through His Holy Spirit, is constantly present in His Church. In the Eastern liturgical tradition, on Monday after the Pentecost, known as Monday of the Holy Spirit, we are solemnly commemorating the Person of God the Holy Spirit. Let us pray to God the Holy Spirit with the beautiful words taken from the Exapostilarion of the Pentecost Sunday Matins: “O most Holy Spirit, Who proceeds from the Father through the Son, and Who has now descended upon the uneducated disciples, save and sanctify all those who recognize You as God” (Pentecost Sunday – Sunday Matins, *Divine Office of the Byzantine-Slavonic Rite* (Stamford, CT, USA 2014 / Glen Cove, L.I., NY: The Basilian Fathers, 2014), 733). May our Triune Lord: The Father, The Son, and The Holy Spirit abundantly bless you and your loved ones during this Pentecost season and always, and may He bless with His peace all people in the world, especially in Ukraine and the Middle East, converting the hearts of the aggressors, so that all current wars and conflicts on earth could end soon! Blessed Pentecost!
